
The State Commission on Judicial Conduct determined on February 17, 2026, that Hon. Jordon R. Lilley be removed from judicial office.

The determination of the Commission, its findings of fact, its conclusions of law, and the record of the proceedings upon which the determination is based were transmitted on February 18, 2026, to the Chief Judge of the Court of Appeals in accordance with Judiciary Law § 44(7);

The service and notice requirements of Judiciary Law § 44(7) were complied with by personal service on Hon. Jordon R. Lilley on March 31, 2026;

Proof was obtained that Hon. Jordon R. Lilley received on March 31, 2026, the determination of the Commission, findings of fact, conclusions of law and record of the proceedings upon which the determination is based; no request for review having been made; NOW THEREFORE, in accordance with Judiciary Law § 44(7), it is

ORDERED that the determined sanction is accepted, without costs, and Hon. Jordon R. Lilley is removed from the office of Justice of the Smithville Town Court, Chenango County. Chief Judge Wilson and Judges Garcia, Singas, Cannataro, Troutman and Halligan concur. Judge Rivera took no part.
